## Noosa Local Heritage Review

### Thank you for your feedback

We spoke to people across Noosa Shire from Kin Kin to Peregian Beach, Pomona to Noosa Junction, Tewantin to Boreen Point who generously shared their thoughts about Noosa's special places.

We received over 200 responses to our survey, gathering more than 1,200 place suggestions along the way.



We discovered that places don't have to be old to be considered part of our heritage with the Noosaville Pelican and Elvis on Gympie Terrace mentioned. Newer buildings and structures such as the Cooroy and Noosaville Library, surf clubs, lifeguard towers and unique houses by local architects were also valued.

We have an especially strong attachment to our rivers, beaches and waterways. Some community feedback shared comments such as "*The river is what opened Noosa up, showed the ingenuity of the people and made Noosa what it is now*". This highlights our connection to our waterways and the link they provide between our past and our future.



### What happens now?

Recommendations to share, recognise and conserve local heritage places will be developed based on the feedback received from the community about heritage values, places and place types in the coming months. Thanks again to everyone who participated.
